

Did You Know?

If you are...

- renting out your home for less than six months
- renting out a part of your home for less than six months
- renting out your vacation/investment property for less than six months
- renting out your home during special events (Bike Week, Speed Week, Spring Break, etc.)

... registration and remittance of the 6% Tourist Development Tax to Volusia County and the 6.5% Sales Tax to the State of Florida is required.

Failure to do so is a misdemeanor or felony punishable by a fine or imprisonment. (Florida Statute 212.12(2)(d))
